As a part of the efforts to disseminate the information about the project and present newly developed master study programme of the University of Kragujevac - Financial Management of the Public Administration, on 10 July 2018, at the premises of the Faculty of Economics, representatives of the University of Kragujevac organized an info day for the delegates of the public administration.
